FASTENER TRAINING WEEK GRADS TAKE LEARNING BACK TO THE OFFICE



Fastener Training Week is five-days of accelerated fastener training and plant tours. After passing a final exam, students are eligible for CFS™ designation. There are three Fastener Training Weeks planned for 2024; the first is April 8-12 in Cleveland, followed by August 19-23 in Chicago and November 18-22 in Cleveland.
